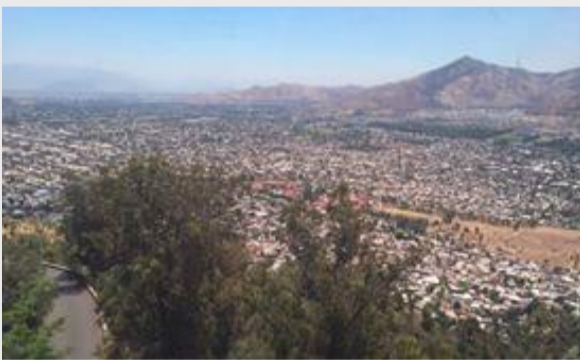


### Why did I apply for a Quest
